**News from Blandford Parish Church:** The C of E Church is pleased to announce that it has appointed Megan Bishop as Children and School's Minister. Megan is a qualified teacher who has been working as Children's, Youth and Families Worker for a large civic church in Coventry. Megan's time during the school term will be spent as a chaplain to the two primary schools within the town. This is a pastoral role seeking to support pupils, families and staff in what is now quite a complex, pressurised and challenging environment.
