

Colehill

Colehill is a rural area with the local town of Wimborne around a mile and a half away. A mix of housing from cottages to flats, houses and bungalows.



Transport

There are 3 buses an hour from Bournemouth to Ferndown, Colehill and on to Wimborne. The main train station is at Bournemouth Central. A smaller station is in Poole.

Amenities

Colehill has a few shops but most of the amenities, including the hospital can be found in Wimborne.

There are a number of schools in this area. Colehill and Hayeswood are First Schools. St Catherine's RC is a Primary School & Kindergarten. There is also St Michael's middle school and Beaucroft Foundation School.



The Methodist Church

The Colehill Methodist Church (chapel) is on the northern edge of Colehill. The small Church is around 110 years old, with extensions comprising of an entrance hall, cloakrooms and an activity hall. The hall is used by dance and exercise groups. We hold Bible Study and Prayer meetings on Monday mornings which are supported by a few members of the Christchurch & Wimborne Circuit. We also have 4 Coffee & Cake mornings a year raising funds for our Church or for a particular charity as the need arises.

Although numbers and age of the fellowship sometimes limit what it can offer the community, its strength is in its warmth and welcome to all. The Church is linked with Wimborne Methodist and Blandford Methodist.
