Amenities

Crowe itself is a very small hamlet of lovely homes, our church and some beautiful walks in the Forest, through fields and down the old railway line.

Ringwood is a large market town with plenty of nice cafés, restaurants, independent shops, larger chain stores, community centres, a library, excellent rated schools (catering from 4-18 years) and a couple of leisure centres.

Ringwood has easy access to a few major hospitals within 15-30mins – Bournemouth, Southampton and Salisbury.

Transport and connections

There is an excellent bus and coach station offering local and national routes.

Bournemouth and Southampton airports (15 mins and 25 mins drive) offer good-priced flights to UK, Channel Islands and European destinations.

Train stations are a short drive away where you can easily get to London in little over an hour, and many other UK destinations.

The ports at Poole and Portsmouth offer ferries to France, Spain and the Channel Islands.

There is a busy cruise ship terminal in Southampton.

Ringwood is on a main through-road offering easy drives to London and the West Country.
